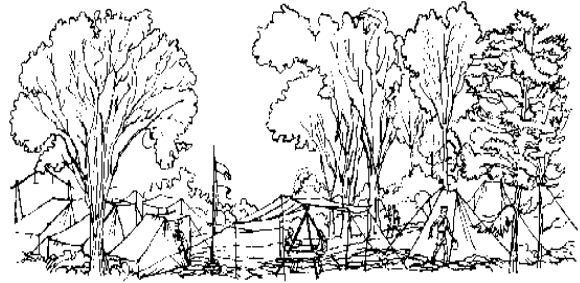


# Troop 90

## CODE of CONDUCT

If I have received a second warning, but continue to break my pledge, I expect my parent(s) to be called to come and take me home or make arrangements to transport me home. Should I break any of the pledges at the next scout activity I attend, an adult will give me one warning, if I continue, I know my parents will be called to take me home or make arrangements to transport me home. If I have been sent home twice, I understand that I must have my parent join me during the next activity I wish to participate in, (camp and overnights included) to help me keep my pledge to myself and the other scouts.
